**THE ELECTRICITY CONCESSION (RATES OF CHARGE)
(ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 1976**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section thirty-one of The Alderney Electricity Concession Law, 1953, as amended (a), hereby order:-

Increase in charges for the supply of electricity.

1. The charges for the supply of electricity to a consumer which the Company shall be entitled to make -
 - (a) under paragraph (a)(ii) of section thirty-one of the Alderney Electricity Law, 1953, as amended, in respect of the quarters ending the 25th March and the 25th December in each year shall be a sum not exceeding 10p for each unit over and above fifteen units; and
 - (b) under paragraph (b)(ii) of the said section thirty-one in respect of the quarters ending the 24th June and the 29th September in each year shall be a sum not exceeding 10p for each unit over and above ten units.

Repeal.

2. The Electricity Concession (Rates of Charge) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1974, is hereby repealed.

Citation.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as The Electricity Concession (Rates of Charge) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1976.

Commencement.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the fifth day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.
