Coming into force 3rd July, 1980

**THE ELECTRICITY CONCESSION (RATES OF
CHARGE) (ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 1980**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section thirty one of the Alderney Electricity Concession Law, 1953, as amended (a), hereby order:-

Increase in charge for the supply of electricity.

1. The charge for the supply of electricity to a consumer, as indicated by meter, which the Company shall be entitled to make in respect of the quarters ending the 25th March, the 24th June, the 29th September and the 25th December in each year shall be 20 pence for each unit consumed.

Repeal.

2. The Electricity Concession (Rates of Charge) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1976 is hereby repealed.

Citation.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Electricity Concession (Rates of Charge) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1980.

Commencement.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the third day of July, nineteen hundred and eighty.
