**The Export of Bovine Semen Ordinance,
1956.**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries, hereby order:—

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section one of the Importation and Export of Bovine Semen and Artificial Insemination by Means of Imported Bovine Semen (Prohibition) Ordinance, 1945, the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries may export bovine semen from this Island for the purposes of the pathological examination and testing of that semen.

2. For the purposes of this Ordinance the Islands of Guernsey and Herm shall be deemed to be one Island and the expression "this Island" shall be construed accordingly.

3. This Ordinance and the Artificial Insemination of Bovine Animals (Prohibition) Ordinances, 1945 and 1952, may be cited together as the Artificial Insemination of Bovine Animals Ordinances, 1945 to 1956.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 20th day of September, 1956.
