Ordinance of the States. **XII**
1950

Made 17th May, 1950.

The Export of Cattle Ordinance, 1950.

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 5th day of April, 1950, hereby order :—

1. (1) During the period beginning on the 1st day of April, 1950, and ending on the 31st day of March, 1951, and during such other period as the States may from time to time by Resolution appoint, the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries may, for the purpose of safeguarding the well-being of this community or of agriculture in this Island, at any time by order impose such restrictions as it may deem necessary on the export of any class of female bovine animals.

(2) Any such order shall be published on a single occasion in La Gazette Officielle, and unless the order otherwise specifies, shall come into force on the day following the date of such publication.

(3) Any such order shall be laid before the States as soon as may be after the making thereof and if, at the meeting of the States in the course of which that order is laid before them or at the next subsequent meeting, the States resolve that the order be annulled, it shall cease to have effect, but without prejudice to anything previously done thereunder or to the making by the said Committee of a new order.

2. A person contravening or attempting to contravene the provisions of any such order as aforesaid shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds in respect of each animal exported or attempted to be exported in contravention of those provisions or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to both such fine and such imprisonment.

3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1950.
