## **The Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1958**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Committee for Horticulture, hereby order:—

1. Subsection (1) of section seven of the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) Ordinance, 1956, is hereby repealed and the following subsection substituted therefor:—

“(1) A person shall not export, cause to be exported or attempt to export flowers from the Island unless—

- (a) the container of the flowers is completely lined with paper; and

- (b) the flowers in the container are completely covered with paper and are held in a reasonably secure position by such method as the Committee may from time to time by order prescribe, and different methods may be so prescribed in respect of different kinds of flowers.”.

2. This Ordinance and the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) Ordinance, 1956, may be cited together as the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) Ordinances, 1956 and 1958.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the fourteenth day of April, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.
