**The Export of Produce (Other than
Tomatoes) (Packing, and Grading)
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1964**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the eleventh day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-three, and on the representations of the States Committee for Horticulture, hereby order:—

1. The Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) Ordinance, 1956, as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”)(a), is hereby further amended, as follows:—

- (a) in the definition of the expression “exporter” in section one thereof the words “name, trade-name, mark, number, description or address”

are hereby repealed and the words "description or code letter and number allocated to him in pursuance of the provisions of subsection (1) of section four of this Ordinance" are hereby substituted therefor;

- (b) subsection (1) of section four thereof is hereby repealed and the following subsection is hereby substituted therefor—

"(1) A person shall not export, cause to be exported or attempt to export produce from the Island otherwise than in a container showing—

- (a) the place of destination of the produce, and
- (b) in bold characters of not less than one-half inch in height the code letter and number which may, from time to time, be allocated to the exporter by the Committee for the purposes of identification,

by imprint or by means of a rubber stamp either on the outside of each end of the container or on a label securely attached to each end of the container.";

- (c) immediately after section seven thereof there is hereby inserted the following additional section and marginal note numbered "7A"—

"Fern and other foliage containers.

7A (1) A person shall not export, cause to be exported or attempt to export fern or other foliage from the Island unless the

container thereof is of a type and size which the Committee may, from time to time, by order direct.

(2) An order made under the provisions of the last preceding subsection may prescribe different types and sizes of containers as respects different kinds of fern and other foliage.

(3) Subsection (1) of this section shall come into force on such date as the Committee may by order appoint."

2. The Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1958, the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1958 and section two of the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1962, are hereby repealed. Repeals.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1964, and this Ordinance, the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1962, and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) Ordinances, 1956 to 1964. Citation and collective title.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the second day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty-four.
