**The Export of Tomatoes
(Packing and Grading) (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1965**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty-five, and on the representations of the States Committee for Horticulture, hereby order:—

1. The Export of Tomatoes (Packing and Grading) Ordinance, 1961, as amended^(a), is hereby further amended, as follows:—

- (a) in subsection (3) of section four thereof, immediately after the word “round” there are hereby inserted the words “and substantially free from air pockets”;
- (b) in subsection (4) of section four thereof, the word “and” where that word first occurs is hereby repealed and a comma is hereby

substituted therefor and immediately after the word "damage" there is hereby inserted a comma and the words "substantially free from air pockets";

- (c) immediately after subsection (2) of section five thereof, there is hereby inserted the following additional subsection numbered "(2A)"—

"(2A) An inspector, duly authorised in writing in that behalf by the President of the Committee, may cut open any tomatoes in the Pink, Pink and White, Pink and White Cross, White or Blue grades delivered to the Board for export which he has reasonable cause to believe are not substantially free from air pockets."

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Export of Tomatoes (Packing and Grading) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1965, and this Ordinance and the Export of Tomatoes (Packing and Grading) Ordinances, 1961 and 1962, may be cited together as the Export of Tomatoes (Packing and Grading) Ordinances, 1961 to 1965.
