Ordinance of the States **XI**

1968

Made 27th March, 1968
Coming into Operation 1st April, 1968

The Export of Tomatoes (Packing and Grading) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1968

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirty-first day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight, hereby order:—

1. The Export of Tomatoes (Packing and Grading) Ordinance, 1961, as amended^(a), is hereby further amended as follows:— **Amendment to Ordinance of 1961.**

(a) subsection (2) of section one thereof is hereby repealed and the following subsection is hereby substituted therefor—

“(2) There shall be marked in clear and legible characters on the outside of each end of, or on the outside of a label securely attached to, containers the prescribed symbol appropriate to the grade of tomatoes therein and the identification number issued to the owner thereof by the Board.”;

- (b) section three thereof is hereby repealed and the following section is hereby substituted therefor—

“3. A person shall not deliver tomatoes or cause tomatoes to be delivered to the Board for export unless at the time of delivery they are clean, firm, of merchantable quality, free from any defect which may affect keeping quality and have reached a state of maturity whereby it can reasonably be expected that not later than seventy-two hours after the day of such delivery those tomatoes will have ripened satisfactorily but will not have exceeded such a state of ripeness ninety-six hours after the day of such delivery.”;

- (c) paragraph (b) of subsection (3) of section five thereof is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor—

“(b) he may order that the load or consignment or any part thereof of which such container forms part be returned to the owner thereof and may require that the load or consignment or part thereof, if redelivered for export, be presented to him for inspection;”;

- (d) in section nine thereof immediately after the definition of the expression “marked”, there is hereby inserted the following definition—

“ “owner” means the person to whom the Board is accountable for the proceeds of the sale of tomatoes delivered to the Board for export;”.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Export Citation.

(2) This Ordinance and the Export of Tomatoes
(Packing and Grading) Ordinances, 1961 to 1965,
may be cited together as the Export of Tomatoes
(Packing and Grading) Ordinances, 1961 to 1968.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the Commence-
first day of April, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight. ment.
