## Ordinance of the States **XLII**

**1975**

Made ... .. 18th December, 1975.  
Coming into Operation ... 1st January, 1976.

### **The Export of Tomatoes (Packing and Grading) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1975**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Committee for Horticulture, hereby order:—

1. Section two of the Export of Tomatoes (Packing and Grading) Ordinance, 1961, as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”)(a), is hereby further amended as follows:—

Amendment to Ordinance of 1961

- (a) in subsection (1) thereof the words “six or twelve pounds” are repealed and the words “three or six kilograms” are substituted therefor;
- (b) in subsection (2) thereof the words “twelve pounds” are repealed and the words “six kilograms” are substituted therefor;
- (c) in subsection (3) thereof the words “six pounds” and the words “twelve pounds”

are repealed and the words "three kilograms" and "six kilograms" are respectively substituted therefor;

(d) in paragraph (a) of subsection (4) thereof the words "six pounds and one ounce" are repealed and the words "three thousand and thirty grams" are substituted therefor;

(e) in paragraph (b) of subsection (4) thereof the words "twelve pounds and two ounces" are repealed and the words "six thousand and sixty grams" are substituted therefor.

Temporary provisions for containers of tomatoes in 1976.

2. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of section two of the principal Ordinance as amended by the provisions of the last preceding section, a person may, during any period in the year nineteen hundred and seventy-six approved by the Committee in that behalf, deliver tomatoes or cause tomatoes to be delivered to the Board for export packed in containers designed to contain twelve pounds of tomatoes such delivery being in accordance with such arrangements as may be approved, and subject to such conditions as may be imposed, by the Committee from time to time.

(2) The weight of tomatoes in a container delivered in accordance with the provisions of the last preceding subsection shall be not less than twelve pounds and two ounces net.

(3) Any person who delivers tomatoes or causes tomatoes to be delivered to the Board under the provisions of subsection (1) of this section:—

(a) otherwise than—

(i) during a period approved by the Committee,

- (ii) in accordance with arrangements approved by the Committee, and
- (iii) subject to any conditions imposed by the Committee, or

(b) in contravention of the provisions of subsection (2) of this section,

shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, in the case of a first offence to a fine not exceeding twenty pounds and in the case of a second or subsequent offence to a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds.

3. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Export of Tomatoes (Packing and Grading) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1975. Citation, construction and collective title.

(2) This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance shall be construed as one.

(3) This Ordinance and the Export of Tomatoes (Packing and Grading) Ordinances, 1961 to 1974, may be cited together as the Export of Tomatoes (Packing and Grading) Ordinances, 1961 to 1975.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-six. Commencement.
