**The Hired Motor Vehicles (Alderney) (Amendment)
Ordinance, 2011**

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 16th March, 2011, and in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 46 of the Government of Alderney Law, 2004^a and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

Amendment of the 1972 Ordinance.

1. (1) The Hired Motor Vehicles (Alderney) Ordinance, 1972^b is amended as follows.

(2) In section 1(1) (interpretation) -

(a) for the definition of "owner" substitute -

""owner", in relation to any motor vehicle, means the person in respect of whom that motor vehicle is, for the time being, registered under the Motor Taxation and Licensing (Guernsey) Law, 1987;" and

(b) for the definition of "police officer" substitute -

""police officer" means a member of the salaried police force of the Island of Guernsey, a member of any police force which may be established by the States of Alderney and, within the limits of his jurisdiction, a special constable appointed by the Court of Alderney under section 47 of the Government of Alderney Law, 2004;".

(3) In section 2 (certain hired motor vehicles to be registered and to carry "H" plates) -

(a) in subsection (2) -

(i) for paragraph (a) substitute -

"(a) the date on which the motor vehicle was first registered under the Motor Taxation and Licensing (Guernsey) Law, 1987 or, if the motor vehicle was first registered or licensed in accordance with the law of a country or territory outside Alderney or

Guernsey, the date, if known, on which it was first so registered or licensed;", and

(ii) in paragraph (b), for the words "licensed in accordance with the provisions of the said Law" substitute "registered or licensed as set out in paragraph (a)",

(b) in subsection (3), after the words "the Committee shall" where first occurring insert ", subject to subsection (3A)", and

(c) after subsection (3), insert the following subsection -

"(3A) The Committee shall not be required to cause a motor vehicle to be inspected before registering it, where, as at the date of the receipt of the application by the Committee, no more than 12 months have elapsed since the date on which the vehicle was registered or licensed for the first time anywhere in the world, whether such first registration or licensing was -

(a) in Alderney or Guernsey under the Motor Taxation and Licensing (Guernsey) Law, 1987; or

(b) in another country or territory

under the law of that country or territory."

(4) For section 3 (period of validity of registration) substitute -

"3. The registration of a motor vehicle under the provisions of this Ordinance shall -

(a) be valid until the expiry of a period of twelve months starting from the date of the registration, and

(b) thereafter be valid, on the renewal of the registration in accordance with section 4, from the date of such renewal until the expiry of a period of twelve months starting from the date of such renewal."

Interpretation.

2. (1) In this Ordinance -

"enactment" means any Law, Ordinance or subordinate legislation, and

"subordinate legislation" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any enactment and having legislative effect.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^c applies to the

interpretation of this Ordinance.

(3) Any reference in this Ordinance to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Hired Motor Vehicles (Alderney) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2011.

Commencement.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 16th March, 2011.
