Ordinance of the States XI 2001

Made ..... 2nd May 2001
Coming into operation ..... 3rd May 2001

THE HORSES (CONTROLLED PLACES) (ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 2001

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 46 of the Government of Alderney Law, 1987, as amended(a), hereby order :—

- 1. For the purposes of this Ordinance the places mentioned in the Schedule to this Ordinance are controlled places in the months of June, July, August and September. ~ Controlled places.
2. The owner or person in charge of a horse shall not permit it to be in a controlled place. Horses in controlled places.
3. A person who contravenes section 2 of this Ordinance is guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding level 1 on the Alderney Uniform Scale. Offence.
4. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(b) applies to the interpretation of this Ordinance as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment. Interpretation.

- Citation.** 5. This Ordinance may be cited as the Horses (Controlled Places) (Alderney) Ordinance, 2001.
- Commencement.** 6. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 3rd day of May 2001.
