## **The Horses (Controlled Places) (Alderney) Ordinance, 2001**

**THE STATES**, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 46 of the Government of Alderney Law, 1987, as amended<sup>a</sup>, hereby order: –

### **Controlled places.**

1. For the purposes of this Ordinance the places mentioned in the Schedule to this Ordinance are controlled places in the months of [May] June, July, August and September.

### **Horses in controlled places.**

2. The owner or person in charge of a horse shall not permit it to be in a controlled place.

### **Offence.**

3. A person who contravenes section 2 of this Ordinance is guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding level 1 on the Alderney Uniform Scale.

**Interpretation.**

4. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>b</sup> applies to the interpretation of this Ordinance as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

**Citation.**

5. This Ordinance may be cited as the Horses (Controlled Places) (Alderney) Ordinance, 2001.

**Commencement.**

6. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of May 2001.
