The Housing (Control of Occupation) (Variation of Schedules) Ordinance, 1983

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-third day of February, nineteen hundred and eighty-three, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section thirty-five of the Housing (Control of Occupation) (Guernsey) Law, 1982(a), hereby order:—

- (1) The list of dwellings identified and named in the First Schedule to the Housing (Control of Occupation) (Guernsey) Law, 1982 (hereinafter referred to as “the Law”) is hereby varied by adding to the said First Schedule at the end thereof the identification and name of each of the dwellings set out in Part I of the Schedule to this Ordinance.
- (2) The list of dwellings identified and named in the Second Schedule to the Law is hereby varied by adding to the said Second Schedule at the end thereof the identification and name of each of the dwellings set out in Part II of the Schedule to this Ordinance.

Citation. 2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Housing (Control of Occupation) (Variation of Schedules) Ordinance, 1983.

Commencement. 3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of June, nineteen hundred and eighty-three.
