THE HOUSING (EXEMPTIONS) (ALDERNEY)
(No. 2) ORDINANCE, 1999

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 1(1)(c) and 11 of The Housing (Control of Occupation and Development) (Alderney) Law, 1994(a), hereby order :—

1. (1) Subject to the provisions of subsections (2) and (3): **Persons exempted.**
- Miss Michelle Catherine Benfield of 11 Birdcage Row, Alderney;**
 - Mr Kenneth Barry Croxton and his Wife Mrs Sharon Croxton of Davidsons Flats, Le Brecque, Alderney;**
 - Mr Tyrone Patrick McCormack and his Wife Mrs Letitia Ruth McCormack of Bayfield, Les Venelles, Alderney;**
 - Mr Geoffrey Christopher Neal and his Wife Mrs Venetia Ann Neal of Clinic Flat, Alderney Animal Welfare, Le Val, Alderney**

who have formed themselves into an association known as **THE RUE LES JOY (SOUTHSIDE) RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION** are hereby prescribed for the purposes of section 1(1)(c) of The Housing (Control of Occupation and Development) (Alderney) Law, 1994.

(a) Ordres en Conseil No. XXI of 1994; No. VII of 1997 and No. X of 1999.

(2) The provisions of subsection (1) shall apply only in relation to an application for permission for the construction of four individual dwellings on plots number F249(a)(1), F249(a)(2), F249(a)(3) and F249(a)(4) respectively in Section 4 of the Alderney Land Register and which plots are situate to the South Side of the road known as Rue Les Joy.

(3) For the removal of doubt, the provisions of The Building and Development Control (Alderney) Law, 1975 shall apply in relation to the application described in subsection (2) in all respects and the permission which may be granted hereunder shall not count towards the number of permits for the time being prescribed under Section 14 of that law.

Interpretation.

2. (1) The provisions of The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Ordinance.

(2) Any reference in this Ordinance to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as The Housing (Exemptions) (Alderney) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1999.
