THE HOUSING (EXEMPTIONS) (No 3) (ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 2009

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 33(1)(c) and 75 of the Building and Development Control (Alderney) Law, 2002(a) ("the 2002 Law"), hereby order:-

1. (1) Subject to the provisions of this section, Jonathan Kirkwood Moxey of 28 Stanley Road, Broadstairs, Kent, CT10 1DA, Caroline Yates of 11a Chapel Street, Farnborough, Hampshire, GU14 8AH, and David Moxey of 79 Cyprus Road, Titchfield Common, Fareham, Hampshire, PO14 4LA ("the applicants") are hereby prescribed for the purposes of section 33(1)(c) of the 2002 Law.

(2) The provisions of subsection (1) apply only in relation to the applicants' application for permission to subdivide the premises known as Les Jumeaux, Route de Crabby, Alderney which forms land registered as entry number AY38 in the Alderney Land Register, into two separate dwellings.

(3) For the avoidance of doubt, the provisions of the 2002 Law, other than section 33 thereof, apply in relation to the application described in subsection (2) in all respects.

(4) The permission which may be granted by the Committee pursuant to this Ordinance does not count towards

the number of permissions for the time being prescribed under section 15 of the 2002 Law.

Interpretation.

2. (1) In this Ordinance -

"**the applicant**" " mean the individuals defined in section 1(1) of this Ordinance,

"**the Committee**" means the Building and Development Control Committee of the States of Alderney,

"**the 2002 Law**" means the Building and Development Control (Alderney) Law, 2002,

and other expressions have the same meanings as in the 2002 Law.

(2) The provisions of the Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(b) apply to the interpretation of this Ordinance.

(3) Any reference in this Ordinance to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation and commencement.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Housing (Exemptions) (No. 3) (Alderney) Ordinance, 2009 and shall come into force on the day that it is approved by the States of Alderney.
