THE HOUSING (EXEMPTIONS) (ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 1999

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Sections 1(1)(c) and 11 of The Housing (Control of Occupation and Development) (Alderney) Law, 1994 (a), hereby order :—

1. (1) Subject to the provisions of subsections (2) and (3), Mount Hale Limited, whose registered office is situate at The Arsenal, Alderney, is hereby prescribed for the purpose of Section 1(1)(c) of The Housing (Control of Occupation and Development) (Alderney) Law, 1994.

**Control of
Construction of
Dwellings**

- (2) The provisions of subsection (1) shall apply only in relation to an application for permission for the construction of 10 dwellings comprising 7 two-bedroomed and 3 one-bedroomed flats within the building known as Block B of the former military establishment called and known as The Arsenal at Whitegates in the Island of Alderney and which said Block forms part of plot numbered F80 in Section 5 of the Alderney Land Register.

(3) For the removal of doubt, the provisions of The Building and Development Control (Alderney) Law, 1975 shall apply in relation to the application described in subsection (2) in all respects.

Interpretation.

2. (1) The provisions of The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 (b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Ordinance.

(2) Any reference to this Ordinance to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Housing (Exemptions) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1999".
