Ordinance of the Chief Pleas  
entitled  
The Housing (Temporary Provisions)  
(Prescribed Persons) Ordinance, 1989

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 1(1)(c) and 2(1)(f) of the Housing (Temporary Provisions) (Sark) Law, 1976 (a), as amended (b), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and in pursuance of their Resolution of the 18th day of January, 1989, hereby order:-

Prescribed persons for purposes of section 1(1)(c) of the Law.

1. Any person -
  - (a) who has been ordinarily resident in the Island for periods amounting in the aggregate to at least 15 years; or
  - (b) who is ordinarily resident in the Island and is the spouse or surviving spouse of a person who is, or was, of the description set out in paragraph (a),is hereby declared to be a person of a prescribed description for the purposes of section 1(1)(c) of the Law.

Prescribed persons for purposes of section 2(1)(f) of the Law.

2. Any person -
  - (a) who is for the time being employed in a professional capacity by the Chief Pleas;
  - (b) who has been ordinarily resident in the Island for periods amounting in the aggregate to at least 15 years;
  - (c) who is ordinarily resident in the Island and is the spouse or surviving spouse of a person who is, or was, of the description set out in paragraph (b); or
  - (d) is a member of the household of a person referred to in paragraphs (a), (b) or (c),is hereby declared to be a person of a prescribed description for the purposes of section 2(1)(f) of the Law.

Interpretation.

3. In this Ordinance "the Law" means the Housing (Temporary Provisions) (Sark) Law, 1976.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Housing (Temporary Provisions) (Prescribed Persons) Ordinance, 1989.
