Ordinance of the Chief Pleas

The Housing (Temporary Provisions)  
(Prescribed Persons) Ordinance, 1990

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 1(1)(c) and 2(1)(f) of the Housing (Temporary Provisions) (Sark) Law, 1976(a), as amended(b), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

Prescribed persons  
for purposes of  
section 1(1)(c)  
of the Law.

1. The Trustees for the Bailiwick of Guernsey Methodist Church Purposes (as established by the Methodist Church (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1987(c)) are hereby declared to be persons of a prescribed description for the purposes of section 1(1)(c) of the Law.

Prescribed persons  
for purposes of  
section 2(1)(f)  
of the Law.

2. Any person -  
(a) who is for the time being, under the direction of the Superintendent Minister of the Bailiwick of Guernsey Circuit of the Methodist Church, fulfilling the offices and duties required of a Methodist Minister within the Island of Sark; or  
(b) who is a member of the household of a person referred to in paragraph (a),  
is hereby declared to be a person of a prescribed description for the purposes of section 2(1)(f) of the Law.

Interpretation.

3. In this Ordinance "the Law" means the Housing (Temporary Provisions) (Sark) Law, 1976.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Housing (Temporary Provisions) (Prescribed Persons) Ordinance, 1990.
