**The Housing Control (Rateable Value)  
Ordinance, 1966**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-ninth day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-six, and in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (1) of section one of the Housing Control (Emergency Provisions) (Guernsey) Law, 1948, as amended(a), hereby order:—

1. The amount of the rateable value referred to in subsection (1) of section one of the Housing Control (Emergency Provisions) (Guernsey) Law, 1948, as amended, which determines that a person who does not possess the qualifications as to residence set out in the said subsection shall not occupy a dwelling within the meaning of the said Law without a licence in that behalf granted by the States Housing Authority, shall, on and after the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance, be eighty-five pounds sterling per annum.
