Ordinance of the States **LVII**
1967

Made 13th December, 1967.

Coming into Operation 1st January, 1968.

The Housing Control Ordinance, 1967

THE STATES, in pursuance of the provisions of subsection (2) of section one and subsection (2) of section four of the Housing Control (Guernsey) Law, 1967(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The amount of the rateable value referred to in subsection (2) of section one of the Housing Control (Guernsey) Law, 1967 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Law”) which determines that a dwelling of which the rateable value does not exceed that amount shall be a dwelling to which that Law applies, shall, on and after the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance, be eighty-five pounds sterling per annum.

Alteration of rateable value.

2. The provisions of paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section four of the principal Law are hereby suspended.

Suspension of section 4(1)(a).

- Repeals. 3. The Housing Control (Suspension of Exemption) Ordinance, 1965(b), and the Housing Control (Rateable Value) Ordinance, 1966(c), are hereby repealed.
- Citation. 4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Housing Control Ordinance, 1967.
- Commencement. 5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.
