**The Immature Spirits (Guernsey)  
Ordinance, 1976**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (2) of section one of the Immature Spirits (Guernsey) Law, 1976(a), hereby order:—

1. Subsection (1) of section one of the Immature Spirits (Guernsey) Law, 1976, is hereby varied as follows:—

- (a) immediately after the words “for a period of at least three years” there are inserted the words “or, in the case of rum, at least two years”;
- (b) in paragraph (e) thereof immediately after the words “imported Geneva,” there are inserted the words “imported vodka.”

Variation of minimum period for warehousing of rum.

Citation. 2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Immature Spirits (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1976.

Commencement. 3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of August, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.
