**The Immigration (Registration of Aliens)
(Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1975**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Board of Administration and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (3) of section four of the Immigration Act 1971 as extended to the Bailiwick by the Immigration (Guernsey) Order 1972(a), hereby order:—

1. Subsection (3) of section eight of the Immigration (Registration of Aliens) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1972 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”)(b), is hereby repealed and the following subsection is hereby substituted therefor—

“(3) An alien who is not a national of a state which is a member of the European Economic Community shall pay to the registration officer concerned the appropriate fee specified in the following Table:—

(b) Recueil d'Ordonnances Tome XVIII, p. 225.

For a certificate issued on registration otherwise than as mentioned below	£2.50
For a certificate issued on registration in respect of a wife or a child under 18 years at the time of registration, where a family is registered together	£0.50
For a certificate issued in replacement of one issued previously	£1.00"

- Extent. 2. This Ordinance shall have effect throughout the Bailiwick.
- Citation. 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Immigration (Registration of Aliens) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1975.
- Collective title. 4. This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Immigration (Registration of Aliens) (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1972 and 1975.
