**The Import and Export (Plant Health)
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1987**

THE STATES LEGISLATION COMMITTEE,
in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by
Article 66(3) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948(a),
hereby orders:—

1. In the Import and Export (Plant Health) Ordinance, 1982(b), as amended(c)— **Amendment.**

(a) in Part I of the First Schedule, after entry
7 insert—

“7A. *Frankliniella occidentalis* (Per-
gande)—Western Flower Thrips.”;

(b) in column 3 of Part IA of the Second
Schedule, after condition (6) of Item 1
insert—

“ (7) The consignment shall be
accompanied by an official statement
that the plants comprising it were—

(b) No. XXIII of 1982.
(c) No. XXVIII of 1984.

- (a) officially examined immediately prior to export and found to be free from Western Flower Thrips (*Frankliniella occidentalis* (Per-gande)), and
- (b) grown at a place of production at which Western Flower Thrips (*Frankliniella occidentalis* (Per-gande)) is not known to have occurred during the four weeks prior to the date on which the plants were removed from such place.”.

Citation.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Import and Export (Plant Health) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1987.

Collective title.

3. This Ordinance and the Import and Export (Plant Health) Ordinances, 1982 and 1984, may be cited together as the Import and Export (Plant Health) Ordinances, 1982 to 1987.
