**The Imported Fish (Amendment)  
Ordinance, 1968**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirtieth day of October, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight, hereby order:—

1. The Ordinance entitled “Ordonnance relative au Poisson Importé, 1935” of the sixth day of July, nineteen hundred and thirty-five<sup>(a)</sup> (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”), is hereby amended as follows, that is to say:—

- (a) in section one thereof, the word “shrimps” is hereby repealed and the words “any crustacea” are hereby substituted therefor;
- (b) in section three thereof, the word “shrimps” is hereby repealed and the words “any crustacea” are hereby substituted therefor.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Imported Fish (Amendment) Ordinance, 1968.
