The Imported Milk Ordinance, 1988

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 4th day of May 1988, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 2(1)(a) and 8 of the Milk and Milk Products (Alderney) Law, 1957, hereby order: –

Control of distribution of imported milk.

1. No person other than the Committee (or an agent of the Committee duly authorised so to do) shall sell, or supply by way of business, milk which has not been produced in the Island.

Offence and penalty.

2. A person who contravenes or attempts to contravene this Ordinance is guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding [level 4 on the Alderney uniform scale].

NOTE

In section 2, the words and figure in square brackets were substituted by the Uniform Scale of Fines (Alderney) Law, 1989, section 2(2), with effect from 1st October, 1989.

Citation.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Imported Milk Ordinance, 1988.

Commencement.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 9th day of May, 1988.
