**The Model Aircraft (Vale Commons)
(Prohibition) Ordinance, 1974**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-seventh day of March, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, hereby order:—

1. A person shall not fly or attempt to fly any power-driven model aircraft in any part of that area of the Parish of the Vale known as “les Communes du Valle” and under the control and supervision of the Vale Commons Council by virtue of the provisions of Article 2 of the Ordinance of 1932.

2. Any person who contravenes the provisions of the last preceding section shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding twenty-five pounds and the Court may, in addition, order the seizure, destruction or other disposal of the model aircraft to which the conviction relates at the expense of the convicted person.

3. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:—

“the Ordinance of 1932” means the Ordinance entitled “Ordonnance relative aux Communes du Valle” of the twenty-fifth day of June, nineteen hundred and thirty-two, as amended (a);

“the Vale Commons Council” means the Council called “le Conseil des Communes du Valle” and constituted in accordance with the provisions of Article 2 of the Ordinance of 1932.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Model Aircraft (Vale Commons) (Prohibition) Ordinance, 1974.
