**THE MOORING CHARGES (AMENDMENT) (ALDERNEY)  
ORDINANCE, 1986**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 4<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1986 and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 1(1) and 2 of the Mooring Charges (Alderney) Law, 1976(a), hereby order:-

**Amendments to Ordinances of 1980.**

1. In the Mooring Charges (Alderney) Ordinance, 1980, as amended (b) -

- (a) in section 3, for "three pounds" there is substituted "£4";
- (b) in section 4(a), for "£100" is substituted "£150";
- (c) in section 4(b), for "£100" there is substituted "£150";
- (d) for the Schedule there is substituted the Schedule to this Ordinance.

**Interpretation.**

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(c) applies to the interpretation of this Ordinance as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment in force in the Island of Alderney.

**Repeals.**

3. The Mooring Charges (Amendment) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1984 and section 1(a) of the Mooring Charges (Amendment) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1982 are repealed.

**Citation.**

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Mooring Charges (Amendment) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1986.

**Collective Title.**

5. This Ordinance and the Mooring Charges (Alderney) Ordinances, 1980 and 1982 may be cited together as the Mooring Charges (Alderney) Ordinances, 1980 and 1986.

**Commencement.**

6. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1987.

Mooring charges in Little Crabby Harbour and at any place within 20 yards of any part of the Sapper Slipway

Classes of Boats	Rates of mooring charges for each mooring charges year
Length overall of the boat, including any fixed bowsprit, pulpit, bumkin and davit:	
Not exceeding 15 feet	£30
Exceeding 15 feet	£50
