

GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT2010 No. 119**The Road Traffic (Clearways) (Amendment) Order 2010***Made*16<sup>th</sup>*December, 2010**Coming into operation**22<sup>nd</sup> December, 2010*

THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 2 of the Road Traffic (Clearways) Ordinance, 1999<sup>1</sup>, hereby orders:-

**Amendment to the Road Traffic (Clearways) Ordinance, 1999.**

1. In Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Clearways) Ordinance, 1999 for paragraph 3 substitute –

"3. Fountain Street, At all times  
Saint Peter Port

This paragraph does not apply between the hours of 6.00 p.m and 7.30 a.m, 9.30 a.m and 12 noon, or 2.00 p.m and 4.00 p.m to any person causing or permitting a delivery vehicle to stop in a loading bay for no longer than is necessary in order to unload goods from and load goods into that vehicle."

**Interpretation.**

2. (1) In this Order, unless the context requires otherwise -

"**enactment**" means any Law, Ordinance or subordinate legislation and

"subordinate legislation" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any enactment and having legislative effect.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>2</sup> applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

(3) Unless the context requires otherwise, references in this Order to any enactment are references thereto as amended, varied, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.


#### Citation
