The Misuse of Drugs (Designation) Order, 1976

Made 1st April, 1976

Laid before the States ...28th April, 1976

Coming into operation ... 1st June, 1976

THE STATES BOARD OF HEALTH, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (4) of section six of the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974, hereby orders:-

Controlled drugs to which section 6(4) of the Law applies.

1. The controlled drugs specified in the Schedule to this Order are hereby designated as drugs to which subsection (4) of section six of the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974, applies.

Citation and commencement.

2.(1) This Order may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs (Designation) Order, 1976.

(2) This Order shall come into force on the first day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.

Controlled drugs to which subsection (4) of section six, of the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974, applies

1. The following substances and products, namely:-

Bufotenine.	Lysergide and other <u>N</u> -alkyl derivatives of lysergamide.
Cannabinol.	Mescaline.
Cannabinol derivatives.	Psilocin.
Cannabis.	Raw opium. 4-Bromo-2, 5-dimethoxy- α -methylphenethylamine.
Cannabis resin.	<u>N,N</u> -Diethyltryptamine.
Coca leaf	<u>N,N</u> -Dimethyltryptamine.
Concentrate of poppy-straw.	2,5-Dimethoxy- α , 4-dimethylphenethylamine.

Lysergamide.

- Any stereoisomeric form of a substance specified in paragraph 1 above.
- Any ester or ether of a substance specified in paragraph 1 or 2 above.
- Any salt of a substance specified in any of paragraphs 1 to 3 above.
- Any preparation or other product containing a substance or product specified in paragraphs 1 to 4 above.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport)

Subsection (3) of section six of the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974, requires an Ordinance to be made by the States to allow the use for medical purposes of the drugs which are subject to control under that Law. That subsection does not, however, apply to any drug designated by order under subsection (4) of the said section six as a drug to which the said subsection (4) is to apply. This Order designates for this purpose the drugs specified in the Schedule to the Order.
