The Post Office (Money Order) (Amendment) Order, 1975

THE STATES POST OFFICE BOARD, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections twenty-nine, thirty-three and sixty-eight of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969, as amended(a), hereby orders:-

Amendments
to Order
of 1973.

1. The Post Office (Money Order) Order, 1973, as amended(b), is hereby further amended as follows:-

(a) paragraph (a) of section two thereof is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor:-

"(a) no oversea telegraph money order for an amount exceeding fifty pounds and no inland telegraph money order for an amount exceeding one hundred pounds may be applied for;"

(b) the First Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Order is hereby substituted therefor.

Repeal.

2. The Post Office (Money Order) (Amendment) Order, 1974(c), is hereby repealed.

Citation.

3. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Money Order) (Amendment) Order, 1975.
