The Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers)
(Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1975

Made 27th March, 1975.
Laid before the States
Coming into operation 1st April, 1975.

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section twelve of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of regulation two of the principal regulations

1. In sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph (1) of regulation two of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1972, as amended, the words "one and a half pence" are hereby repealed and the figures and word "1.75 pence" are hereby substituted therefor.

Citation, collective title and commencement

2.(1) These regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1975.

(2) These regulations and the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1972 and 1974, may be cited together as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1972 to 1975.

(3) These regulations shall come into operation on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy-five. Dated this twenty-seventh day of March, nineteen hundred and seventy-five.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations further amend the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1972, by increasing the allowance payable to approved suppliers in respect of the container of any drug or medicine supplied by them under and in accordance with the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972, from 1.50p. to 1.75p.
