THE STATES POST OFFICE BOARD, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections thirteen, sixteen, nineteen and sixty-eight of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969, as amended(a), hereby orders:-

1. The Post Office (Overseas Letter Post) Order, 1973, as amended(b), is hereby further amended as follows:-

- (a) in paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section six thereof the figures and letter "4.5p" are hereby repealed and the words "five new pence" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (b) paragraph 3 of Part 5 of the First Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor:

"3. Printed Papers:

Weight not exceeding 1 oz.	4p
exceeding 1 oz. but not exceeding 2 oz.	5p
exceeding 2 oz. but not exceeding 4 oz.	6p
exceeding 4 oz. but not exceeding 8 oz.	8.5p
exceeding 8 oz. but not exceeding 1 lb.	15p
exceeding 1 lb. but not exceeding 1 lb. 8 oz.	20p "

Citation. 2. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Overseas Letter Post) (Amendment) Order, 1975.

Commencement. 3. This Order shall come into force on the twenty-eighth day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy five.
