**The Medicines (Human) (Special Appointed Day) (Bailiwick  
of Guernsey) Order, 2010**

**THE HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 24 and 132 of the Medicines (Human and Veterinary) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2008<sup>a</sup> and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

**Special appointed day.**

1. The day appointed for the purposes of section 24(1) of the Medicines (Human and Veterinary) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2008<sup>b</sup> is 1<sup>st</sup> October 2010.

**Interpretation.**

2. (1) A reference in this Order to an enactment, or any provision or part of it, is a reference to it as amended, or re-enacted or re-made (with or without modification), or extended or applied by or under any enactment.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>c</sup> applies to the interpretation of this Order –

(a) throughout the Bailiwick, and

(b) for the avoidance of doubt, as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

(3) For the avoidance of doubt, an expression used in this Order has the same meaning as in the Law.

**Extent.**

3. This Order has effect throughout the Bailiwick.

**Citation and commencement.**

4. This Order may be cited as the Medicines (Human) (Special Appointed Day) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 2010 and comes into force immediately.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

The special appointed day for the purposes of section 24(1) of the Medicines (Human and Veterinary) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2008 will be 1 October 2010.

The requirements for marketing authorisations and wholesale dealer's licences will not apply to any exportation done before this date. The effect of this appointment is to provide some flexibility to allow exports of stock already in the system.

This date has been appointed because it is necessary or expedient to do so to give effect to the Memorandum of Understanding between the Secretary of State for Health and the States of Guernsey Health and Social Services Department, signed on the 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2008.
