**THE MOTOR VEHICLES (INTERNATIONAL CIRCULATION) (DRIVING PERMIT FEE) ORDER, 2008**

6<sup>th</sup> March 2008

Coming into force

1<sup>st</sup> April 2008

**THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT**, in accordance the powers conferred upon it by section 1(4) of the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) Ordinance, 1974, as amended<sup>(1)</sup>, hereby orders:-

**Prescribed fee**

1. For the purposes of section 1(4) of the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) Ordinance, 1974, as amended, the fee prescribed for the issue of a driving permit issued under section 1 (1) of that Ordinance shall be seven pounds and fifty pence.

**Repeal.**

2. The Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) (Driving Permit Fee) Order, 2006<sup>(2)</sup> is hereby repealed.

**Citation.**

2. This Order may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) (Driving Permit Fee) Order, 2008.

**Commencement.**

3. This Order shall come into force on the first day of April 2008.
