

The Gambling (Public Lotteries) (Repeal) Order, 1975

Made 14th May, 1975

Coming into operation ... 15th May, 1975

THE STATES GAMBLING CONTROL COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section eight of the Gambling (Public Lotteries) Ordinance, 1973(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby orders:-

Repeal of Order of 1973

1. The Gambling (Public Lotteries) Order 1973(b) is hereby repealed.

Saving

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section one of this Order, the provisions of subsection (2) of section six of the Gambling (Public Lotteries) Order, 1973, shall continue to have effect in relation to the payment of prizes to agents under the provisions of the Gambling (Public Lotteries) Ordinance, 1973, and section three of the Gambling (Channel Islands Lottery) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1975(c).


Interpretation

3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(d) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

Citation and Commencement

4. This Order may be cited as the Gambling (Public Lotteries) (Repeal) Order, 1975, and shall come into force on the fifteen day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy-five.
