The Water Supply (Control) (Guernsey)
Regulations, 1976

Made 19th May, 1976.
Laid before the States ... 1976.
Coming into operation ... 19th May, 1976.

THE STATES OF GUERNSEY EMERGENCY COUNCIL, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (1) of section two of the Emergency Powers (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1965, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:-

1.(1) Notwithstanding any of the provisions of the Law entitled "Loi ayant rapport à la Fourniture d'Eau par les Etats de cette Ile aux Habitants de la dite Ile" registered on the seventh day of May, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, as amended, the States Water Board (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") shall not be required during any period to supply by measure water to any person in excess of such percentage as shall from time to time be determined by the President of the Board of the smallest quantity of such water so supplied during the similar period in any of the years nineteen hundred and seventy-three, nineteen hundred and seventy-four or nineteen hundred and seventy-five.

(2) The President of the Board may under the provisions of the last preceding paragraph determine different percentages in respect of different classes of persons and different persons within those classes.

2.(1) When the President of the Board determines any percentage in accordance with the provisions of the last

preceding regulation he shall serve a notice in writing on any person whose supply of water by the Board will be effected by such determination informing the said person of the amount of the percentage determined, the date on which it will be effective and the period during which it will be effective.

(2) Any notice which may be served for the purposes of these Regulations shall be validly served on any person, if delivered to him, left, or sent by post or by recorded delivery service to him at the premises on which the supply of water to which the notice relates is measured.

3. These Regulations shall have effect in the Island of Guernsey.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Water Supply (Control (Guernsey) Regulations, 1976.

5. These Regulations shall come into force on the *nineteenth* day of *May* nineteen hundred and seventy-six.
