THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section one of the Merchant Shipping Act 1965 as extended to the Bailiwick of Guernsey by the Merchant Shipping Act 1965 (Guernsey) Order 1969, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

1. In the definition of the expression "surveyor of ships" in paragraph (1) of Regulation 16 of the Merchant Shipping (Tonnage) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, immediately after the word "Board" there are hereby inserted a comma and the words "and in relation to pleasure yachts under 45 feet (13.7 metres) in overall length Lloyds Register of Shipping, the Royal Yachting Association or the Yacht Brokers, Designers and Surveyors Association".

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Tonnage) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1975, and shall come into operation on the first day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-five.
