

THE FAMILY ALLOWANCES (RECIPROCAL AGREEMENT WITH SPAIN)  
(GUERNSEY) REGULATIONS, 1975

6th June, 1975

Laid before the States

Deemed to have come into operation 1st April 1975

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section twenty-three of the Family Allowances (Guernsey) Law, 1950, as amended, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:--

MODIFICATION OF THE LAW

1. The provisions contained in Article 22 of the Convention on Social Security set out in the Schedule to these Regulations (which extends to the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou) shall have full force and effect, and the Family Allowances (Guernsey) Law, 1950, as amended, shall have effect subject to such modifications as may be required therein for the purpose of giving effect to the provisions contained in that Article.

CITATION. EXTENT AND COMMENCEMENT

2. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Family Allowances (Reciprocal Agreement with Spain) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1975.

(2) These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

(3) These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the First day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy five.
