The Water Supply (Control) (No.3) (Guernsey)  
Regulations, 1976

Made ... .. 19th May, 1976.  
Laid before the States ... 1976.  
Coming into operation ... 19th May, 1976.

THE STATES OF GUERNSEY EMERGENCY COUNCIL, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (1) of section two of the Emergency Powers (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1965, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:-

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Law entitled "Loi ayant rapport à la Fourniture d'Eau par les Etats de cette Ile aux Habitants de la dite Ile" registered on the seventh day of May, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, as amended, the States Water Board shall not be required to extend, lay or fix pipes or apparatus for the purposes of a supply of water, or to supply water, in respect of any requisition or request made to the said Board under the provisions of the said Law before or after the date of the coming into force of these Regulations save that the said Board may, in its discretion, supply water:-

- (a) during such hours on any day as the said Board may determine, and
- (b) by means of standpipes erected by the said Board or in such other manner as the said Board may, from time to time, determine.

2. These Regulations shall have effect in the Island of Guernsey.

3. These Regulations shall come into force on the nineteenth

day of May nineteen hundred and seventy-six.
