



**The Terrorism and Crime (Bailiwick of Guernsey)  
(Amendment)  
Regulations, 2008**

**THE HOME DEPARTMENT**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 15C of the Terrorism and Crime (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2002<sup>a</sup> and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

**Amendment of 2007 Regulations.**

1. In the 2007 Regulations, in regulations 1(1) and 2(1) for "15C" substitute "15A".

**Interpretation.**

2. (1) In these Regulations, the "**2007 Regulations**" means the Terrorism and Crime (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2007<sup>b</sup>.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>c</sup> applies to the interpretation of these Regulations.

(3) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

**Citation and commencement.**

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Terrorism and Crime (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2008 and shall come into force on the 19<sup>th</sup> May, 2008.
