The Milk (Retail Prices) (No 2) (Guernsey) Order, 1975.

THE STATES DAIRY COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (1) of section eight of the Milk (Control) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1958, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby orders:-

1. (1) Subject to the provisions of the next succeeding sub-paragraph, the price to be charged on a sale by retail of milk, whether or not produced in this Island, shall be -

(a) during the period commencing on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and seventy-five, and ending on the twenty-ninth day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-five, at the rate of eleven new pence per pint;

(b) during the period commencing on the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-five, and ending on the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-six, at the rate of eleven and one half new pence per pint.

(2) The provisions of sub-paragraph (1) of this paragraph shall not apply to any milk supplied to a beneficiary under any scheme for the time being in force provided by the States for the supply of milk whether free of cost or at a reduced price.

2. The Milk (Retail Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1975, is hereby revoked.

3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

4. This Order may be cited as the Milk (Retail Prices) (No 2)

(Guernsey) Order, 1975, and shall come into force on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and seventy-five.
