

The Post Office (Inland Post) (Amendment) Order, 1975.

Made 13th January, 1975.
Laid before the States 26th February, 1975.
Coming into Operation 20th January, 1975.

THE STATES POST OFFICE BOARD, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, eighteen, twenty, twenty-three, twenty-eight and sixty-eight of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969, as amended, hereby orders:-

Amendment to
Schedule to
Order of
1973.

1. Immediately after paragraph 17 of the Second Schedule to the Post Office (Inland Post) Order, 1973, as amended, there is hereby inserted the following additional paragraph:-

"18. Private Delivery Service. For separating postal packets addressed to the same address according to such codes, private box numbers, descriptions, words, figures, characters or marks used with the address as may have been approved for the purpose by the Board and for delivery by postman to a single point in advance of the general delivery:-

- (1) for initial period of
one year or less ... Such fee as the Board may fix
for a minimum period of one year
in the particular case;
- (2) for each subsequent
full year ... Such fee as the Board may fix for
that year in the particular case;
- (3) for a subsequent part
only of a year ... A rateable proportion of the fee
chargeable under (2).

Citation. 2. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Inland Post)
 (Amendment) Order, 1975.

Commencement. 3. This Order shall come into force on the twentieth
 day of January , nineteen hundred and seventy-five.
