

**The Births, Deaths and Marriage Certificates (Fees)
Regulations, 2009**

Made *27th January*, 2009
Coming into operation *1st February*, 2009
Laid before the States , 2009

THE TREASURY AND RESOURCES DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 1 and 5 of the Fees, Charges and Penalties (Guernsey) Law, 2007^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:-

Amendment of fees.

1. The Births, Deaths and Marriages Certificates (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Guernsey) Law, 1951^b ("the 1951 Law") is amended in accordance with the provisions of these Regulations.

Fee for short form birth certificate.

2. In section 1(2) of the 1951 Law for "£10"^c substitute "£11.50".

Fee for full birth, death and marriage certificates.

3. In sections 1(3), 2 and 3 of the 1951 Law for "£15" substitute "£17.50".

Repeal.

4. Sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Births, Deaths and Marriage Certificates (Fees) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2006^d are repealed.


Citation.

5. These Regulations may be cited as the Births, Deaths and Marriage Certificates (Fees), Regulations, 2009.

Commencement

6. These Regulations shall come into force on 1st February, 2009.
