The Gambling (Channel Islands Lottery) (Bailiwick of
Guernsey) Order, 1975

Made 23rd June 1975

Coming into operation 1st July 1975

THE STATES GAMBLING CONTROL COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections four, six, eight and nine of the Gambling (Channel Islands Lottery) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 1975 (a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby orders:-

INTERPRETATION

- 1.(1) In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires -
- "apparatus" means the apparatus described in paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section two of this Order;
 - "container" means a container forming part of the apparatus;
 - "digit prize" means a prize awarded in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section eight of the Ordinance;
 - "jackpot prize" has the meaning assigned to it by paragraph (c) of subsection (3) of section two of this Order;
 - "numbered prize" means a prize awarded in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section eight of the Ordinance;
 - "the Ordinance" means the Gambling (Channel Islands Lottery) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 1975;
 - "presiding officer" means the person appointed or chosen as such in accordance with the provisions of section six of the Ordinance;
 - "tumbled" means moved and stirred by operation of the apparatus;
- and any other expression shall have the same meaning as in the Ordinance.

- (2) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in this Order to any other enactment or order shall be construed as including a reference to that enactment or order, as the case may be, as amended, repealed and replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment or order, including this Order.

to the interpretation of this Order throughout the Bailiwick.

MANNER OF CONDUCTING DRAWS

2.(1) For the purpose of conducting draws, the Committee shall provide:-

- (a) a sufficient staff to ensure the effective conduct of the draws;
- (b) an apparatus consisting of five containers numbered consecutively from 1 to 5 (hereinafter referred to respectively as "the first container", "the second container", "the third container", "the fourth container" and "the fifth container") and so constructed that their contents may be tumbled electrically or mechanically, each such container being provided with a means by which tokens may be removed singly;
- (c) all such other equipment as may be necessary for:-
 - (i) the effective conduct of the draw;
 - (ii) the verification and recording of serial numbers and of prizes drawn;
 - (iii) the public announcement of such serial numbers and prizes.

(2) Immediately before the time appointed for the draw, the presiding officer shall examine the apparatus and shall satisfy himself that the apparatus, together with the equipment provided in pursuance of paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of this section, is in proper working order, and he may invite any members of the public then present to examine the apparatus.

(3) Each draw shall consist of the drawing of:-

- (a) numbered prizes in accordance with subsections (4) and (5) of this section;
- (b) digit prizes in accordance with subsection (6) of this section; and
- (c) the drawing of a single prize (being either the Jackpot or first prize) in accordance with subsections (7) and (8) of this section.

(4) At the time appointed for the draw, or as soon as may be thereafter, the presiding officer shall:-

- (a) for the purpose of drawing the serial numbers of the winning tickets, cause to be placed:-
 - (i) in the first container tokens numbered consecutively, indicating the thousands in the serial numbers of tickets sold in relation to the draw;
 - (ii) in each of the second, third and fourth containers, ten tokens numbered consecutively from 0 to 9, indicating respectively the hundreds, tens and units in such serial numbers;

- (b) for the purpose of drawing the numbered prizes, cause to be placed in the fifth container tokens each of which shall bear a mark indicating the prize to which it relates.

(5) The drawing of the serial numbers, and of the numbered prizes shall be effected in the manner following, that is to say, the presiding officer:-

- (a) shall cause the contents of all five containers to be thoroughly tumbled;
- (b) thereafter, shall cause one token to be removed from each of the first four containers in order, and shall cause one token to be removed from the fifth container;
- (c) shall cause:-
 - (i) the serial number and the prize so drawn to be verified and recorded, and thereafter publicly announced;
 - (ii) the tokens removed from the first four containers to be replaced in the container from which they were removed;
 - (iii) the token removed from the fifth container to be put aside;

and the procedure set out in this paragraph shall be repeated until the tokens in the said fifth container have all been drawn.

(6) The drawing of the serial number in respect of a digit prize shall be effected in the manner following, that is to say, the presiding officer:-

- (a) shall ensure that the contents of the first four containers are as set out in paragraph (a) of subsection (4) of this section;
- (b) shall cause the contents of the first four containers to be thoroughly tumbled;
- (c) thereafter, shall cause one token to be removed from each of the first four containers in order;
- (d) shall cause the serial number so drawn to be verified and recorded and thereafter publicly announced;
- (e) if the Committee has specified that more than one serial number shall be drawn for the purpose of determining the allocation of digit prizes shall cause the tokens removed from the first four containers to be replaced in the containers from which they were removed after each serial number has been publicly announced;
- (f) shall cause the processes set out in paragraphs (b), (c), (d) and (e) of this subsection to be repeated until all digit prizes so specified have been drawn.

(7) Subsection (4) of this section shall apply in relation to the drawing of the jackpot prize, or the first prize, as the case may be, as it applies in relation to the drawing of numbered prizes, except that in paragraph (b) thereof:-

- (a) for the words "numbered prizes" there shall be substituted the words "jackpot prize" or the first prize;

- (b) for the words "token each of which shall bear a mark indicating the prize to which it relates" there shall be substituted the words "a gold token indicating the jackpot prize, and the appropriate number of black tokens, each indicating the first prize, determined in accordance with sub-paragraph (d) of subsection (8) of this section, the value of the prize being determined by the colour of the token drawn".

(8) Subsection (5) of this section shall apply to the drawing of the jackpot prize or the first prize as the case may be as it applies to drawing of numbered prizes, as though for paragraph (c) thereof there were substituted the following paragraphs:-

- "(c) shall cause - the serial number, and the colour of the token so drawn to be verified and recorded, the value of the prize to be determined and the serial number and the value of the prize to be publicly announced;
- (d) the number of black tokens placed in the fifth container in accordance with paragraph (b) of subsection (7) of this section shall be as follows:-
- (i) in the first draw which includes a jackpot prize, such number of tokens as may be specified;
 - (ii) in each draw subsequent to that in which a black token is drawn, the number of such tokens shall be reduced by one;
 - (iii) in the first draw subsequent to that in which the gold token is drawn, such number of tokens as may be specified;

DRAWING OF CERTAIN SERIAL NUMBERS TO BE NULL AND VOID

3. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, where a serial number is drawn which is the serial number of a ticket which has not been sold either to an agent in the Bailiwick of Guernsey or to an agent appointed by the Jersey Committee, the presiding officer shall:-

- (a) declare the drawing of that serial number to be null and void;
- (b) cause the tokens removed from the first four containers to be replaced in the containers from which they were removed; and
- (c) cause another serial number to be drawn in place of the first mentioned serial number.

AGENTS COMMISSION OF WINNING TICKET

4. The prescribed commission for the purposes of subsection (5) of section eight of the Ordinance shall be one half of one per centum of the value of the prize to which the winning ticket relates.

MARKING OF TICKETS

5. For the purposes of subsection (5) of the section four of the Ordinance, every ticket and, where a ticket is divisible into parts, every part of every ticket purchased by the Committee from the Jersey Committee for sale of agents shall be perforated or marked with a distinguishing mark in the form set out in the Schedule to this Order.


REPEAL

6. The Gambling (Channel Islands Lottery) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order 1975 (c) is hereby repealed.

CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

7. This Order may be cited as the Gambling (Channel Islands Lottery) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1975, and shall come into force on the day of _____, nineteen hundred and seventy-five.
