

**The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets)
(Bruce Lane) Regulations, 2010**

April, 2010

Coming into operation

26th May, 2010

THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT, in the exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 1 of the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950^a, and of all powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in the localities of this Island referred to in these regulations:-

Amendment to 1989 Ordinance.

1. The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989,^b is amended by inserting, immediately after paragraph 1 of Part I of Schedule 1, the following paragraph –

"1A. Bruce Lane, in the section from a point 20 metres to the south of its junction with Les Amballes, to its junction with the Corbin Steps: this paragraph applies only to vehicles which have a laden weight on one axle exceeding three tons."

Interpretation.

2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise -

"**Department**" means the Environment Department,

"**enactment**" means any Law, Ordinance or subordinate legislation,

"**laden weight**" in relation to a vehicle, means the actual weight of the vehicle as loaded with persons, animals, goods and fuel, and

"**subordinate legislation**" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any enactment and having legislative effect.

- (2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^c applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

- (3) Unless the context requires otherwise, references in these Regulations to any enactment are references thereto as amended, varied, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) (Bruce Lane) Regulations, 2010.

Commencement and Expiry


4. These Regulations come into force on the 26th May, 2010 and cease to have effect –

- (a) at the end of the period of 12 months commencing with the date on which they are made, or

(b) on any earlier date determined by Order of the Department.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

The purpose of this notice is to reintroduce an experiment implementing a laden weight (on one axle) restriction for vehicles travelling along this road to minimise the risk of damage being caused to roadside properties due to heavy goods traffic.
