The Social Insurance (Contributions) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1975

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections five and seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law 1964, as amended, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of principal regulations

1. In paragraph (1) of regulation thirteen, and in regulation fifteen of the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") the words "four hundred and sixty-eight pounds", wherever they occur, are hereby repealed and the words "five hundred and seventy-two pounds" are hereby substituted therefor.

2. Regulation fourteen of the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows, that is to say:-

- (a) the words "four hundred and sixty-eight pounds" wherever they occur therein, are hereby repealed and the words "five hundred and seventy-two pounds" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (b) in paragraph (1) thereof the reference to the Non-Contributory Pensions (Guernsey) Law, 1955 is hereby repealed and a reference to the Supplementary Benefit (Guernsey) Law, 1971, is hereby substituted therefor;
- (c) in paragraph 4 thereof the words "twenty shillings" are hereby repealed and the words "two pounds" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (d) in sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) of paragraph (4) thereof the words "ten shillings and six pence", wherever they occur, are hereby repealed and the words "one pound" are hereby substituted therefor.

Repeal

3. The Social Insurance (Contributions) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1973, are hereby repealed.

Citation, Collective Title and Commencement

4. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1975.

(2) These regulations, the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1970, and the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 to 1975.

(3) These regulations shall come into operation on the third day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-five.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

Regulation one and regulation two (a) are consequential upon the decision of the States on the 25th June, 1975, to increase from four hundred and sixty-eight pounds to five hundred and seventy-two pounds the income limit below which self-employed and non-employed persons may be excepted from liability to pay insurance contributions.

Regulation two (c) and (d) provide for an increase in the amounts which may be disregarded for the purpose of determining whether a person may be excepted from liability to pay contributions.
