

**GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT 2009 No. 36**

**The Control of Intoxicating Liquor (Designated Public Places)  
(Town Seafront) Order 2009**

Made: 13 July 2009

Coming into force: 19 July 2009

THE STATES HOME DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 2(1) and (2) of the Control of Intoxicating Liquor (Designated Public Places) Ordinance, 2007, hereby orders:-

1. In order to prevent nuisance or annoyance to members of the public or a section of the public or disorder which is likely to be associated with the consumption of intoxicating liquor in that place, the area marked in red on the attached plan, that is:-

The junction of the North Esplanade with the Weighbridge Roundabout to the junction of the Quay and Fountain Street, including the Victoria (Crown) Pier

shall be a designated public place for the purpose of the Ordinance on the dates and within the times specified below.

2. From 10.00am to 7.00pm on 19th and 26th July 2009, 10.00am to 7.00pm on 2nd, 9th, 16th, 23rd, 30th and 31st August 2009 and between 10.00am and 7.00pm on 6<sup>th</sup> September 2009.
3. This Order may be cited as the Intoxicating Liquor (Town Seafront) Order 2009.
4. This Order shall come into force on the 19<sup>th</sup> July 2009 and apply for the times and dates indicated above.
