THE STATES POST OFFICE BOARD, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections twenty-nine, thirty-three and sixty-eight of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969, as amended(a), hereby orders:-

Amendment
to Order of

1. In subsection (1) of section thirteen of the Post Office (Money Order) Order, 1975(b), the words "one pound and twenty-five new pence" are hereby repealed and the words "two pounds" are hereby substituted therefor.

Citation.

2. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Money Order) (Amendment) Order, 1975.

Commencement.

3. This Order shall come into force on the twenty-ninth day of September, nineteen hundred and seventy-five.
