THE PARKING PLACES (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2008

Coming into operation

8th August 2008

THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 1 of the Road Traffic (Parking Places) Ordinance, 1963, as amended^a, hereby orders:-

1. The Parking Places Order, 1991, as amended^b, is further amended as follows.
2. In article 10, the words "between midnight of any day and midnight of the next day" are deleted.
3. In article 11, the words "between midnight of any day and midnight of the next day" are deleted.
4. In Part C of Schedule 1, in the third column relating to Disc Parking Place No. DC5a, the words ", but excluding Approved Parking Place No. AC46" are inserted following the words "limits indicated by parking signs".

5. In Part C of Schedule 1, in the third column relating to Disc Parking Place No. DC14, the words, "but excluding Approved Parking Place No. AC34" are deleted.

6. In Part A of Schedule 2, in the third column relating to Approved Parking Place No. AA4, the words ", but excluding Approved Parking Place No. AC44" are inserted following the words "south side of the road".

7. In Part A of Schedule 2, in the third column relating to Approved Parking Place No. AA17, the words, "Places Nos. AB18a and AC38" are deleted and the words, "Place No. AB18a" are inserted.

8. In Part A of Schedule 2, in the third column relating to Approved Parking Place No. AA42, the words, "but excluding between 8.30am and 5pm the portion of the north side of the road within the limits indicated by signs as being reserved for permit holders only" are deleted.

9. In Part B of Schedule 2, for the entry relating to Approved Parking Place No. AB22e substitute the following entry -

AB22e	The Bridge, Vale	The portion of the road at the northern end of the west side of the central reservation within the limits indicated by signs.

10. In Part C of Schedule 2, the entry relating to "Approved Parking Place No AC16" is deleted.

11. In Part C of Schedule 2, the entry relating to "Approved Parking Place No AC34" is deleted.

12. In Part C of Schedule 2, the entry relating to "Approved Parking Place No AC38" is deleted.


13. In Part C of Schedule 2, immediately following the entry relating to Approved Parking Place No. AC43 insert the following entries -

AC44	Belmont Road	The portion of the south side of the road as near as practical to La Sapiniere, within the limits indicated by signs as being reserved for persons in possession of a disabled person's badge.
AC45	Sous Les Hougues, Vale	The portion of the north side of the road as near as practical to its junction with Rue Flere, within the limits indicated by signs as being reserved for persons in possession of a disabled person's badge.
AC46	Cornet Street	The portion of the south side of the road as near as practical to Martel Maides Auction Rooms, within the limits indicated by signs as being reserved for persons in possession of a disabled person's badge.
AC47	Ann's Place	The portion of the north side of the road as near as practical to the Old Government House Hotel, within the limits indicated by signs as being reserved for persons in possession of a disabled person's badge.

14. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places (Amendment) Order, 2008.

15. This Order shall come into force on the 8th August, 2008.
