The Post Office (Miscellaneous Amendments) (No. 2) Order, 1975.

Made 18th September, 1975.
Laid before the States
Coming into Operation 29th September, 1975.

THE STATES POST OFFICE BOARD, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, eighteen, nineteen, twenty, twenty-eight and sixty-eight of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969, as amended(a), hereby orders:-

1. The Post Office (Overseas Letter Post) Order, 1973, as amended(b), is hereby further amended as follows:-

(a) section one thereof is hereby repealed and the following section is hereby substituted therefor:-

"1. (1) The rates of postage specified in Part 1 of the First Schedule to this Order shall be charged and paid on letters and postcards posted in the Bailiwick, or posted on board a ship registered in the Bailiwick while the ship is on the high seas:-

(a) for transmission to a person on board a ship of the Royal Navy (whether on the high seas or in any port or place outside the Bailiwick); or

(b) for transmission to a member of the armed forces of the United Kingdom or of any other Commonwealth country serving outside the Bailiwick with the armed forces of the United Kingdom or of any other Commonwealth country, being transmission through a British Forces' Post Office or a Civilian Postal Administration in any Commonwealth or foreign country which has agreed to deliver without surcharge letters and postcards at the said rates.

Order.

- (2) The rates of postage specified in Part 2 of the First Schedule to this Order shall be charged and paid on all other outgoing letters and postcards posted in the Bailiwick or posted on board a ship registered in the Bailiwick while the ship is on the high seas for transmission to a person anywhere in the world.
 - (3) This section shall not apply to airmail packets.";
- (b) section two thereof is hereby repealed and the following section is hereby substituted therefor:-
- "2. (1) The rates of postage specified in Part 1 of the Second Schedule to this Order shall be charged and paid on outgoing printed packets to which the provisions of this section apply.
- (2) Subject as hereinafter mentioned the provisions of this section apply to:-
 - (a) any newspaper or other periodical publication which complies with the following conditions:
 - (i) it is printed and published in the Bailiwick;
 - (ii) it is issued in consecutive numbers at intervals of not more than one year;
 - (iii) it consists only of paper or of some substance ordinarily used for printing publications;
 - (iv) it is not in the nature of current and personal correspondence and at least one third of the publication consists of articles of a literary character (with or without publicity or advertising matter);
 - (v) the full title, and the date, month or year of issue, or an indication of the frequency of issue, are conspicuously printed on the cover (or, in the absence of a cover, at the top of the first page) and on every detached sheet, page or piece of paper which is issued as part of such newspaper or publication;

(b) any book;

(c) any pamphlets, which expression for this purpose means short printed publications or works of a literary character whether or not enclosed within covers;

(d) any musical scores;

(e) any maps.

(3) The decision of the Board as to whether a particular printed packet comes within the provisions of this section shall be final.";

(c) section three thereof is hereby repealed and the following section is hereby substituted therefor:-

"3. (1) The rates of postage specified in Part 2 of the Second Schedule to this Order shall be charged and paid on all printed packets posted in the Bailiwick or on board a ship registered in the Bailiwick while the ship is on the high seas for transmission to those persons specified in paragraph (a) or (b) (as appropriate) of subsection (1) of section one of this Order.

(2) The rates of postage specified in Part 1 of the Second Schedule to this Order shall be charged and paid on those printed packets specified in subsection (2) of section two of this Order posted on board a ship registered in the Bailiwick while the ship is on the high seas for transmission to any person other than those specified in paragraph (a) or (b) (as appropriate) of subsection (1) of section one of this Order.

(3) The rates of postage specified in Part 3 of the Second Schedule to this Order shall be charged and paid on all All-up newspapers, except those which are posted under the provisions of subsection (1) of this section.

- (4) Except as otherwise provided by section two of this Order or by subsections (1) and (2) of this section the rates of postage specified in Part 4 of the Second Schedule to this Order shall be charged and paid on outgoing printed packets and on outgoing small packets.
- (5) This section shall not apply to air mail packets.";
- (d) in section five thereof the words and figure "Part 3 of the Third Schedule" are hereby repealed and the words and figure "Part 5 of the Second Schedule" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (e) section six thereof is hereby repealed and the following section is hereby substituted therefor:-
- "6. (1) There shall be charged and paid:-
- (a) on every air letter of the smaller size, a rate of postage of 10.5p;
 - (b) on every air letter of the larger size, a rate of postage of eleven new pence;
 - (c) on every Forces air letter, a rate of postage of 6.5p;
 - (d) on other air mail packets, the rates of postage specified in the Third Schedule to this Order.
- (2) In this section, the expression "air letter of the smaller size" means an air letter which (when folded) is approximately 150 millimetres long and 107 millimetres wide, and the expression "air letter of the larger size" means an air letter which (when folded) is approximately 210 millimetres long and 100 millimetres wide.";
- (f) in subsection (1) of section eleven thereof -
- (i) in paragraph (a) the words "three feet five inches" and "two feet eleven inches" are hereby repealed and the words "one thousand and forty millimetres" and "nine hundred millimetres" are hereby respectively substituted therefor;

- (ii) in paragraph (b) the words "eleven pounds" are hereby repealed and the words "five kilograms" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (g) in subsection (2) of section eleven thereof -
 - (i) in paragraph (a) the words "six and three quarter inches" and "four inches" are hereby repealed and the words "one hundred and seventy millimetres" and "one hundred millimetres" are hereby respectively substituted therefor;
 - (ii) in paragraph (b) the words "five and one half inches" and "three and one half inches" are hereby repealed and the words "one hundred and forty millimetres" and "ninety millimetres" are hereby respectively substituted therefor;
 - (iii) in the proviso the words "six and three quarter inches" and "two and three quarter inches" are hereby repealed and the words "one hundred and seventy millimetres" and "seventy millimetres" are hereby respectively substituted therefor;
- (h) in section twenty-four thereof the words "forty new pence" are hereby repealed and the words "sixty new pence" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (i) in paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section twenty-seven thereof the words "thirty-five new pence" are hereby repealed and the words "forty-five new pence" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (j) in subsection (3) of section thirty-two thereof the words "one third of an inch" are hereby repealed and the words "nine millimetres" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (k) paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section thirty-six thereof is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor:-
 - "(a) make a search for the packet, or provide any other service, in order that it may if possible receive expedited customs examination; or";

- (l) in subsection (1) of section forty-two thereof the definition of "Commonwealth country" is hereby repealed and the definition "All-up Newspaper" means an outgoing printed packet consisting of or containing one or more registered newspapers (and nothing else) which is posted to an address in Europe and is marked conspicuously with the words "All-up Newspaper" to indicate the desire of the sender that the packet should be accorded by the Board the same treatment as regards its despatch and delivery from the Bailiwick as that which would be appropriate to a packet transmitted at the letter rate of postage;' is hereby inserted in the appropriate alphabetical position;
- (m) in the Fourth Schedule thereto -
- (i) in Part 1 the word "Yemen" is hereby repealed and the words "Yemen Arab Republic" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (ii) in Part 2 the words "British Honduras", "Falkland Islands", "Hawaii", "Malaysia", "Sabah" and "Sarawak" are hereby repealed and the words "Belize", "Falkland Islands and Dependencies", "Ghana", "Guinea Bissau (formerly part of Portuguese West Africa)", "Malaysia (including Sabah and Sarawak)" and "Tristan da Cunha" are hereby inserted in the appropriate alphabetical positions;
- (iii) in Part 3 the words "Cook Islands", "Marian Islands", "New Guinea Territory" and "Papua" are hereby repealed and the words "Mariana Islands" and "Papua New Guinea" are hereby inserted in the appropriate alphabetical positions;
- (n) in the Eighth Schedule thereto in the first and second columns thereof the figure "19" where this figure occurs in these columns is hereby repealed and the figure "18" is hereby substituted therefor;
- (o) the First, Third, Fifth, Sixth and Seventh Schedules thereto are hereby repealed and the Schedules set out in the First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth and Sixth Schedules to this Order are hereby substituted therefor.

2. The Post Office (Overseas Parcel Post) Order, 1973, as amended(c),
is hereby further amended as follows:-

(a) in section four thereof -

(i) in subsection (1) the words "three feet six inches",
"six feet seven inches" and "twenty-two pounds" are
hereby repealed and the words "one thousand and fifty
millimetres", "two thousand millimetres" and "ten kilo-
grams" are hereby respectively substituted therefor;

(ii) in paragraph (a) of subsection (2) the words "six and
three-quarter inches" and "four inches" are hereby
repealed and the words "one hundred and seventy milli-
metres" and "one hundred millimetres" are hereby respec-
tively substituted therefor;

(iii) in paragraph (b) of subsection (2) the words "five and
one half inches", "three and one half inches", "six and
three-quarter inches" and "two and three-quarter inches"
are hereby repealed and the words "one hundred and forty
millimetres", "ninety millimetres", "one hundred and

(b) in section fifteen thereof the words "forty new pence" are
hereby repealed and the words "sixty new pence" are hereby sub-
stituted therefor;

(c) in subsection (1) of section seventeen thereof -

"one-fifth of an inch", "three inches" and "three feet
six inches" are hereby repealed and the words "ten milli-
metres", "five millimetres", "seventy-five millimetres"
and "one thousand and fifty millimetres" are hereby res-
pectively substituted therefor;

- (ii) in paragraph (e) the words "fifty pounds" are hereby repealed and the words "one hundred pounds" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (d) in section twenty-one thereof -
 - (i) paragraph (a) of subsection (1) is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor:-

"(a) make a search for the parcel, or provide any other service, in order that it may if possible receive expedited customs examination;"
 - (ii) paragraph (a) of subsection (5) is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor:-

"(a) where a parcel is stored for a period not exceeding twenty-eight days, the fee shall be one pound and twenty-five new pence for each parcel, except where two or more parcels are posted simultaneously by a sender to the same addressee, when the fee shall be:-

 - (i) where there are not more than five parcels, one pound for each parcel;
 - (ii) where there are more than five parcels but not more than thirty, one pound for each of the first five parcels and then sixty new pence for each additional parcel;
 - (iii) where there are more than thirty parcels, for the first thirty parcels the fee for each as prescribed in sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of this subsection and then thirty-five new pence for each additional parcel;"
- (e) in the Fourth Schedule thereto in the first column thereof the figures, comma and words "17 inclusive, and 19" and in the second column thereof the figures and words "17 inclusive and 19" are hereby repealed and the figure and word "18 inclusive" are in each case hereby substituted therefor;

- (f) the First, Second and Third Schedules thereto are hereby repealed and the Schedules set out in the Seventh, Eighth and Ninth Schedules to this Order are hereby substituted therefor.

3. The Post Office (Inland Post) Order, 1973, as amended(d), is hereby further amended as follows:-

(a) in Part I of the Arrangement of Sections thereof the figure, full stops and words "2. Additional postage on late posted packets." are hereby repealed;

(b) section two thereof is hereby repealed;

(c) in section ten thereof -

(i) subsection one thereof is hereby repealed and the following subsection is hereby substituted therefor:-

"(1) With regard to any postal packet (other than a parcel or a newspaper chargeable by law with a postage at the lowest rate of postage for the time being payable in respect of a newspaper) which for any reason cannot be delivered, the following provisions shall apply:-

(a) where the full name and address of the sender appear legibly on the outside of the packet, the packet shall be returned to the sender unopened, but subject to payment of any charges to which it has become liable;

(b) where the name and address of the sender do not appear on the outside of the packet or are illegible, the packet shall be opened by an officer of the States Post Office duly authorised in that behalf by the Board, and if the name and address of the sender can be ascertained, the packet shall be returned to the sender, subject to payment of any charges to which it has become liable.";

- (i) in section forty-eight thereof the figures "1969" are hereby repealed and the figures "1975" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (j) in subsection (1) of section fifty-two thereof -
 - (i) the definition of "first class letter" is hereby repealed and the following definition is hereby substituted therefor:-

"first class letter" means any letter posted at a place outside the Bailiwick as a second class letter within the meaning of the law of the place where it is posted;'

- (ii) the definitions of "late posted packet", "preferred envelope" and "preferred letter" are hereby repealed;
- (k) in paragraph (a) of section fifty-four thereof the words, inverted commas, commas, brackets and figure 'the definition of "first class letter", "preferred envelope" and "preferred letter" in subsection (1) of section fifty two,' are hereby repealed;
- (l) in Column two of paragraph 2 of the Fourth Schedule thereto the figure and letter "40p" are hereby repealed and the figure and letter "60p" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (m) in Part I of the Fifth Schedule thereto:-
 - (i) in Column one the figures "0.25", "0.30" and "0.35" are hereby repealed and the figures "0.45", "0.50" and "0.55" are hereby respectively substituted therefor;
 - (ii) in Column two the figures "150", "300" and "500" are hereby repealed and the figures "200", "400" and "600" are hereby respectively substituted therefor;
- (n) in Column one of Part I of the Sixth Schedule thereto the figures "0.05" and "0.10" are hereby repealed and the figures "0.07" and "0.12" are hereby substituted therefor;
